Tree preservation restrictions and environmental awareness through the years have given this unique residential equestrian community a rural feel despite being centrally located. Please join the EAEC in learning about and preserving our unique heritage!

Did you know that our 10,000-acre community is comprised of native forests of mostly longleaf pine, live oak, and turkey oak trees? Our rolling sandhills host a broad range of wildlife species such as protected gopher tortoises, imperiled Southern Fox squirrels, coyotes, bobcats, armadillos, raccoons, wild turkeys, songbirds, snakes, opossums, the occasional black bear and Florida panther, red tail hawks, and a variety of other raptors.

Pine Ridge also boasts twenty-eight miles of riding and walking trails for Pine Ridge horse owners and hiking, all maintained by the community and free from motorized vehicular access.

We invite all property owners, builders, realtors, and tree specialists to join us in preserving Pine Ridge Estates as a jewel of the Nature Coast for one another and for future generations!
