The sand mine application is still active at the County level and State-level developments are ongoing. This is not settled.

Over the past several months, we have seen significant shifts, from the Special Master ruling, to the cancelled BOCC hearing, to State involvement, to new activity and unanswered questions surrounding groundwater and nearby wetlands. Things have continued moving, even when it hasn't been visible.

It affects residents across Citrus County and beyond. Whether you live inside or outside Pine Ridge, you are welcome and we hope to see you. This is a county-wide issue, and everyone is encouraged to attend.
